

3 Person Indoor Sauna

Model SMT-HS311 | Traditional steam sauna — indoor

Overview

Capacity	3 person
External size	160 (W) × 120 (D) × 190 (H) cm
Timber	Canadian hemlock (red cedar option); 8 mm transparent tempered glass; wooden door handle

Heating System

Stove	3.5 kW stove heater standard; 4.5 kW Harvia upgrade available; explosion-proof volcanic stones
Included	Wooden bucket & scoop, drip tray, extra wood supports

Electrical

Power supply	240 V dedicated circuit — hardwired installation by a licensed electrician required (3.5–4.5 kW load)
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Features

Control	Control panel with FM radio, MP3, USB & Bluetooth; double speakers
Comfort	Reading light + 7-colour therapy lamp

Delivery & Assembly

Packaging	8 cartons per unit, approx. 273 kg gross
Largest cartons	A: 196×166×19 cm (~80–88 kg) · B: 196×122×19 cm (~40 kg) · C: 158×118×19 cm (~33 kg) · D: 158×50×14 cm · E: 85×80×14 cm; stove, stones and bucket boxed separately
Assembly	Modular panels — approx. 1 hour, 2 people recommended

Care & Maintenance

- Pour water only over the stones, never directly on the stove body; use the wooden bucket and scoop provided.
- Inspect stones annually — re-stack loosely and replace any cracked or crumbling stones.
- Use the drip tray and wipe away excess moisture after each session.
- Sit on a towel during every session; wipe benches and backrests with a damp cloth after use — no harsh or abrasive chemicals.
- Ventilate the cabin after each session (open door and vent window until dry) to let the timber dry out fully.
- Remove marks on interior timber with a light hand-sand using fine-grit paper; clean glass with a non-abrasive glass cleaner.
