

Single Bench Modern Box Outdoor Sauna

Model SMT-HSR208 | Traditional steam sauna — outdoor

Overview

Capacity	4 person, single bench with wood backrest
External size	180 (W) × 120 (D) × 190 (H) cm
Construction	Canadian hemlock, weatherproof exterior, pitched roof with black roof shingles, vertical batten design, ventilation window

Heating System

Stove	4.5 kW or 6 kW Harvia wall-mount heater; sauna stones included
Included	Wooden bucket & scoop, drip tray, clothes hook

Electrical

Power supply	240 V dedicated circuit — hardwired installation by a licensed electrician required (4.5–6 kW load)
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Features

Control	Control panel with double speakers
Comfort	Reading lamp, LED strip, colourful lights, wooden handle

Delivery & Assembly

Packaging	8 flat-packed cartons per unit
Assembly	Modular panels — approx. 1–2 hours, 2 people recommended; position on a level, drained base

Care & Maintenance

- **Oil the timber (essential):** apply an exterior-grade timber oil to all outside surfaces 2 months after installation in its final location, then every 12 months thereafter to maintain weather protection. No oiling is needed inside the cabin.
- Pour water only over the stones, never directly on the stove body; use the wooden bucket and scoop provided.
- Inspect stones annually — re-stack loosely and replace any cracked or crumbling stones.
- Use the drip tray and wipe away excess moisture after each session.
- Sit on a towel during every session; wipe benches and backrests with a damp cloth after use — no harsh or abrasive chemicals.
- Ventilate the cabin after each session (open door and vent window until dry) to let the timber dry out fully.
- Remove marks on interior timber with a light hand-sand using fine-grit paper; clean glass with a non-abrasive glass cleaner.
- Keep roof shingles clear of leaves and debris; check roof seal each season.
